- Taken action to deal with alcohol-related nuisance in the Town and Rosebery Park

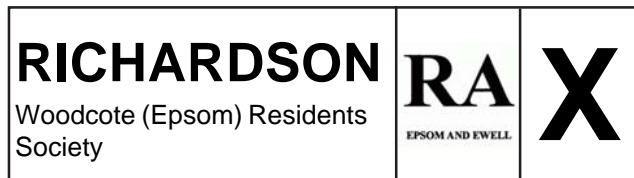
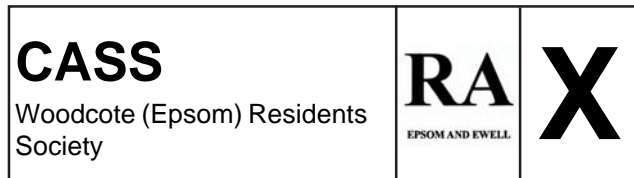
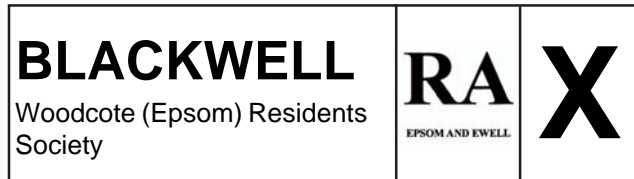
Additionally we will:

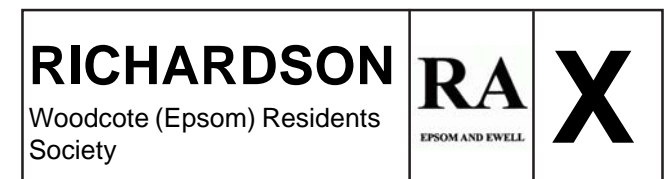
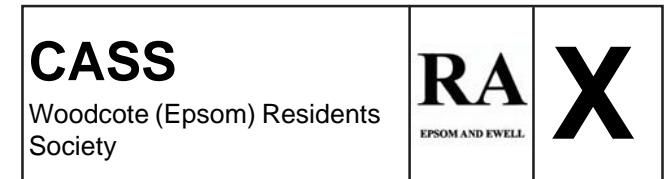
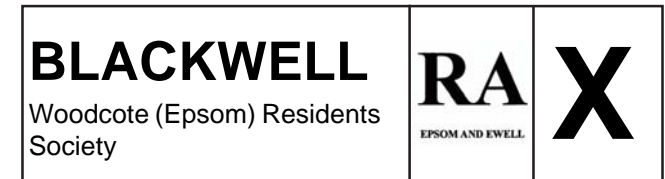
